Number of attendees: 5649


The average number of educational programs over the past three years is 62 with an average number of attendees being 5982.

Chief, we currently have 20 educational occupancies in the township and City of Powell with a total student population of 7035. Based on the lowest purchase request submitted with this letter the average cost per child is \$1.50.

On hand educational materials are nearly exhausted and the request for programs from our customers is growing steadily.
