**WHEREAS**, the Park Department must periodically recondition and paint tennis courts and basketball surfaces; and





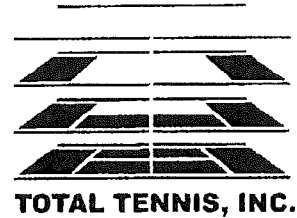
Subject: Tennis court and basketball court sealing and painting.

The following is the information concerning the Basketball Courts and Tennis courts at Liberty Park. If you need additional information, please call.

**Court Reconditioning to Include:**

1. Clean court of debris and prepare for coatings. Scrape and bleach some areas and coat with NovaBond.
2. Repair cracks using Tru-Patch Mix with acrylic binder or Novacaulk. Please note that this is only a temporary solution until more permanent measures can be taken. The cracks will reappear within no definite period of time. Some of the texture from the repair may be seen, but will not affect ball bounce.
3. Apply two coats of Combination Surface. This product is a factory blend of filler material and 100% acrylic color finish, and provides a full depth of texture and color for a uniform playing base and durable wearing surface. Color of your choice.
4. Paint new lines using 100% acrylic textured line paint in order to match the texture of the playing surface.

\$4,329.00 for the Basketball Courts
