RESOLUTION NO: 08-0806-09

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE CONSENSUS OF THE BOARD THAT A COUNTY-WIDE DISASTER ALERTING SYSTEM IS NECESSARY AND REQUESTING THE DELAWARE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO TAKE ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO PLACE A LEVY FOR SUCH A SYSTEM BEFORE THE VOTERS IN THE UPCOMING GENERAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, large portions of both Liberty Township and Delaware County consist of outdoor recreational areas that are currently without emergency alerting; and

WHEREAS, a review has been made of the feasibility of a County-wide Disaster Alerting System consisting of warning sirens located on towers throughout Delaware County; and

WHEREAS, the results of this review clearly indicate that such a system can be effectively and economically installed; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that this issue now be placed before the voters of Delaware County for their determination;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that it is the consensus of the Board of Township Trustees of Liberty Township, Delaware County, Ohio, that the public interest requires the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a County-wide Disaster Alerting System consisting of warning sirens located on towers through Delaware County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Township Trustees encourages the Delaware County Commissioners to take all action necessary to establish such a system and respectfully requests that they place a levy for a county-wide disaster alerting system before the voters in the upcoming general election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Fiscal Officer shall certify a copy of this resolution to the Delaware County Commissioners at his earliest convenience.
