

Resolution #09-0106-07 Authorization of Officers to incur costs

**Whereas**, existing state law provides for the Township Board of Trustees to authorize staff members to have expenditure authority up to a specified amount and subject this authorization to conditions which are deemed appropriate to the efficient and effective operation of the Township,

**Whereas**, such approval is subject to all other applicable laws and the subsequent approval of the Township Administrator and/or the Township Fiscal Officer, and

**Whereas**, the supervisors need to have the ability to make purchases and rent equipment based on operational need for the benefit of the residents and efficient and effective operations,

**Now, Therefore Be it Resolved, by the Liberty Township Board of Trustees, Delaware County, Ohio** approves the following supervisory, managerial and support personnel to have expenditure authority up to the \$2500 Statutory limit, with the above noted conditions and approvals, for the efficient and effective operation of the Township; Fiscal Officer, Township Administrator, Executive Secretary, Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief, Fire Captains, Zoning Inspector, Road Superintendant, Park Superintendant, Zoning Inspector and Assistant Zoning Inspector.

## **507.11 Officers and employees may incur obligations - payment of money.**

(A) The board of township trustees may authorize, by resolution, township officers and employees to incur obligations of two thousand five hundred dollars or less on behalf of the township, or it may authorize, by resolution, the township administrator to so authorize township officers and employees. The obligations incurred on behalf of the township by a township officer or employee acting pursuant to any such resolution shall be subsequently approved by the adoption of a formal resolution of the board of township trustees.

(B) No money belonging to the township shall be paid out, except upon an order signed by at least two of the township trustees, and countersigned by the township fiscal officer.
