Authorizing the expenditure of funds for the Unified Threat Device

WHEREAS, Liberty Township budget has been submitted to and approved by the Board of Trustees, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to update and replace the Liberty Township filtering system with a Unified Threat Management device solution to handle website content, spam filtering, and perimeter security, replacing the current Cisco PIX which is no longer supported, and

WHEREAS, the cost for a 3-year subscription to the spam and website content system is approximately \$9,185.00; but Liberty Township has been given a 20% discount due to the current system being no longer support bringing the final cost to approximately \$7350.00, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Liberty Township Board of Trustees, Delaware County, Ohio, that the Township Administrator is authorized to expend funds not to exceed \$7,500.00 in accordance with the submitted proposal for equipment and professional installation services from Info-Link of Mt. Vernon at 601 Pittsburgh Ave.


This Resolution shall be in force and become effective immediately upon its execution.





Discuss web filtering strategies, we are currently acting reactively and do no content or category based blocking. We have not had any issues with this yet, but I feel that this is something we should address to prevent future issues or litigation. I have done extensive research on available options for Jackson Township as our existing filtering expired and we were not happy with its functionality. The solution we are most likely going to adopt is from Astaro (www.astaro.com) It is considered a Unified Threat Management device and handles website content, spam filtering, perimeter security (replacing our Cisco PIX which is end of life and not supported) For a 3-year subscription to the spam and website content updates, it runs around \$9,185. However, as a Cisco Pix user, we are entitled to a 20% discount as a trade-in on that rate, making our cost closer to \$7350. Detailed breakdown below.

- o Astaro Security Gateway 220 (Provides web content filtering, spam protection, encryption and perimeter defense)
 - \$9,185 = 3-year (Hardware: 2,550; Mail Security: 2,395; Web Security: 3,075; Maintenance: 1,165)
