Modifying the Definition of the Work week

Whereas, the definition of "work week" used in hiring resolutions is "A work week shall be defined as that period of time beginning at midnight on Monday morning and continuing until midnight the following Sunday evening and continuing 168 consecutive hours."

Whereas, this definition is defined pursuant to 29 U.S.C. §207(K)

Whereas, this definition is not the same as that used by OPERS or OP&FPF or the payroll system.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO:

1. To define the "work week" as "A work week shall be defined as that period of time beginning at midnight on Saturday morning and continuing until midnight the following Friday evening and continuing 168 consecutive hours."
2. This definition replaces all uses of the previous definition in all prior and future documents executed by the Township effective June 20, 2009.
