

RESOLUTION 09-0803-03

IN THE MATTER OF DECLARING THE NECESSITY FOR MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS TO VARIOUS TOWNSHIP ROADS AS PART OF THE DELAWARE COUNTY PORTION OF THE MID-OHIO REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION'S ALLOCATION OF FEDERAL STIMULUS (ARRA) FUNDING, APPROVING PLANS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT, AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ENGINEER TO ACT AS CONTRACT ADMINISTRATOR.

Whereas, Sections 5573.01 to 5573.06 of the Revised Code provide that a Board of Township Trustees may find that the public convenience and welfare require the improving of any public road or part thereof by grading, draining, paving, straightening, or widening such road, and may order the County Engineer to prepare surveys, plans, profiles, cross sections, estimates of cost, and specifications for the Improvement;

Whereas, Delaware County and the various townships, cities and villages within have received funding through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 to be used for Improvements including resurfacing or pavement reconstruction on various roads and streets;

Whereas, the County Engineer has prepared plans for said Improvements and recommends approval of the plans, specifications and estimates for the Improvement which includes resurfacing or pavement reconstruction on following roads and streets:

W. Orange Road east of Perry Road and west to the Orange Township line;
London Road from U.S. Route 42 approximately 500 feet north in the City of Delaware;
Cheshire Road (County Rod 72) from U.S. Route 23 to Braumiller Road in the City of Delaware;
Bale Kenyon Road (Township Road 107) from East Powell Road to Lewis Center Road;
West Orange Road (Township Road 114) from Perry Road to U.S. Route 23;
Liberty Road (County Road 9) from the CSX Railroad to State Route 750 in the City of Powell;
Liberty Road (County Road 9) from Freedom Lane to London Road in the City of Delaware;
Cheshire Road (County Road 72) from the Sunbury Corp. Line to U.S. Route 36 in Sunbury;
Concord Road (Township Road 129) from the Dublin Corporation Line to Cook Road;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Liberty Township:

Section 1: That the public convenience and welfare require the preventative maintenance, resurfacing or reconstruction of pavement on the roads listed above, and that the Project known as DEL-COUNTY RESURFACING (PID 86579) be initiated for said purpose, and;

Section 2: That the plans prepared by the County Engineer for said Project are hereby approved for construction, and that the Township Administrator shall sign any required plans, specifications or contract documents on behalf of the Board to facilitate the Project, and;

Section 3: That the County Engineer is authorized to administer the construction contract for this Project on behalf of the Township, and;

Section 4: That no (city or township) funding is required for this Project and that no special levies or assessments shall be made to pay the costs of the Project, and that all costs shall be paid for with ARRA funding.

This Resolution shall be in force and become effective immediately upon its execution.
