General Rules:

- Defacement, destruction, removal or disturbance of any building, sign, equipment or natural vegetation within the park is prohibited.
- No persons shall bring to, leave behind, or dump any materials of any kind in the park except the refuse, ashes, garbage and other materials of a picnic, camp or other permitted activities. Such materials shall be deposited in the receptacles provided.
- Fire, other than fires in grills or fireplaces is prohibited. All fires must be extinguished before leaving the park.
- Pets must be on a leash or must be controlled by their owners at all times. Owners of pets will be responsible for removal and proper disposal of droppings left behind by said animals. No animals are permitted around the concession, athletic fields or tot-lots. No horseback riding is permitted in the park.
- No persons shall possess, consume or display beer, malt liquor, malt beer, wine or liquor or any unprescribed drugs in the park. No persons are permitted on the park grounds while under the influence or intoxicated by alcohol or unprescribed drugs.
- No persons shall use, discharge, possess or carry firearms, air or gas guns, bows, crossbows, missile throwing objects, or sling shots in the park.
- No persons shall operate radios, phonographs, tape recorders or musical instruments at a volume audible beyond their immediate area.
- Soliciting, sales and advertising of any kind on park grounds is prohibited without express permission from the park supervisor.
- Minor children under the age of twelve (12) years shall be escorted by or under the supervision of responsible parents, guardians or adults at all times. Parents of minor children under the age of eighteen (18) are at all times responsible for the actions and safety of their children while on park property.
- Any person using an athletic field or game court in the park shall limit duration of usage to one (1) hour when other people are waiting to use said field or court unless reserved ahead of time.
- All organized athletic events must be approved by the park supervisor.
- No person shall fly remote control airplanes, or shoot rockets, or fireworks within park limits. No swimming in the park's fishing pond. No person shall ice skate on the fishing pond without permission from the park supervisor. Rollerblading and roller skating are prohibited on tennis courts.
- Motorized vehicles are allowed on designated roads and only at the displayed speed and shall park only in the designated areas. Any vehicle left in the park after closing hours will be removed at the owner's expense.

Compliance with Rules and Regulations: The park supervisor or Liberty Township Trustees are authorized to issue orders or directives to park visitors when in their opinion any person in the park is not complying with rules and regulations or are participating in any activities that constitutes a hazard to themselves or to others or is in any way being a nuisance or disturbing the peace of the park. Upon continued disregard of said order, directive or prohibition, the offending person(s) may be asked to leave the park or will be ejected by the proper authorities.

Terms of Agreement: All users and persons occupying or using the Liberty Township Park assume the risk of all injuries. All persons or organizations responsible for injury or damage to persons or property agree to hold Liberty Township and all of its officials and employees free and harmless from any and all claims, suits of any kind arising out of or in connection with the use of said park by the aforementioned responsible person or organization.
