

RESOLUTION #09-1221-07: OPTIONS FOR TOWNSHIP OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES WHO ELECT NOT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TOWNSHIP'S HEALTH CARE PLAN OR ARE DENIED COVERAGE

Whereas, the township has established a self-insurance program under ORC§9.833(B)(1) and a health savings program ORC§9.833(B)(2) which may provide benefits as described in ORC§505.60(A), and

Whereas, ORC§505.60(C) states that

If any township officer or employee is denied coverage under a health care plan procured under division (B) of this section or if any township officer or employee elects not to participate in the township's health care plan, the township may reimburse the officer or employee for each out-of-pocket premium that the officer or employee incurs for insurance policies described in division (A) of this section that the officer or employee otherwise obtains, but not to exceed an amount equal to the average premium paid by the township for its officers and employees under policies it procures under division (B) of this section.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO:


- 1. The Township will reimburse officers and employees who elect not to participate in the Township's health care plan as provided in ORC§505.60(C) at 50% of the amount equal to the average premium paid by the Township upon the officer or employee signing a statement affirming that the officer or employee is covered under another health insurance or health care policy, contract, or plan in the case of a health benefit, or a life insurance policy in the case of a life insurance benefit, and setting forth the name of the employer, if any, that sponsors the coverage, the name of the carrier that provides the coverage, and an identifying number of the applicable policy, contract, or plan, and**
- 2. The Township will reimburse officers and employees who are denied coverage at an amount not to exceed the average premium paid by the Township for like insurance coverage which is secured by the officer or employee, all as permitted by ORC§505.60(C).**





This Resolution, except for provision 3, shall be in force and become effective immediately upon its execution.


