**Approve stop sign request for Wedgewood Park Estates on Creighton Drive**

**WHEREAS**, Wedgewood Park Estates residents have submitted a petition and are requesting a stop sign due to dangerous through traffic in their subdivision, and

**WHEREAS**, residents have expressed concern over increased traffic and cut-through traffic in their subdivision and are requesting a stop sign be installed at the intersection of Creighton Drive and Pine Creek Drive, and

**WHEREAS**, residents have also referenced similar issues and stop signs being installed in neighboring subdivisions,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO** that the Board approves the installation of stop sign at the intersection of Creighton Drive with Pine Creek Drive.

We the undersigned residents of Creighton Drive in Wedgewood Park Estates, a residential subdivision located in Liberty Township, Ohio, hereby petition the Liberty Township Trustees for the installation of a 3-way stop sign system at the intersection of Creighton Drive and Pine Creek Drive. In addition to the current stop sign on Pine Creek at Creighton Drive, we are requesting the installation of two stop signs on Creighton Drive: one sign on Creighton Drive westbound at Pine Creek and one sign on Creighton Drive eastbound at Pine Creek.

Creighton Drive is a heavily-traveled residential street which serves as the primary route for travel through the neighborhood. Additionally, although Creighton Drive was not designed to carry significant amounts of non-neighborhood traffic, there is ample evidence to suggest that Creighton Drive increasingly is being used by non-residents as a cut-through from S.R. 750 to S.R. 257. The corner of Pine Creek Drive and Creighton Drive serves as a bus stop for children, many of whom need to cross Creighton Drive in order to reach the bus stop.

We respectfully request the Trustees approve this request promptly in order to make the intersection of Creighton Drive and Pine Creek Drive safe for the residents of Wedgewood Park Estates.
