**Approve the Daughters of the American Revolution Marker Request**

**Whereas**, the Delaware City Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution wishes to place a commemorative bronze marker at the grave of Thomas Cellar, a Revolutionary War Patriot, who is buried in the Liberty Presbyterian Cemetery at St. Rt. 315 and Home Road, and

**Whereas**, the bronze marker will measure 6 inches high by 9 inches wide and will bear the patriot's name, dates of birth and death, military rank and name of the Delaware City Chapter (a photo of the proposed marker is attached), and

**Whereas**, the Liberty Township Trustees are the governing body for this cemetery,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE LIBERTY TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO**, approve the Daughters of the American Revolution Marker as requested, with the condition that if there are any additional costs involved it would be at the expense of the requestor.


This Resolution shall be in force and become effective immediately upon its execution.

Dear Liberty Township Trustees,

The Delaware City Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution wishes to place a commemorative bronze marker at the grave of Thomas Cellar, a Revolutionary War Patriot, and who is buried in the Liberty Presbyterian Cemetery at the corner of St. Rte. 315 and Home Road.

The bronze marker will measure 6 inches high by 9 inches wide and will bear the patriot's name, dates of birth and death, his military rank, and the name of the Delaware City Chapter. Because the present head stone at the grave is not suitable on which to mount the commemorative plaque, it will be necessary to place a small flat 4 inch thick granite stone in front of the current head stone and attach the plaque to it. (A picture from the plaque manufacturer is attached.)

Recognizing that Liberty Township Trustees are the governing body for this cemetery, we are respectfully requesting permission to place the above described commemorative plaque.

The National Society DAR requires that *"a written statement authorizing installation of the grave marker [be obtained] from the cemetery owner or authority. This statement must show the person's authority to give consent to install the marker and must specifically cite the name of the person whose grave is to be marked."*

We will be happy to furnish any other specifics that you may request and answer questions that you may have.
