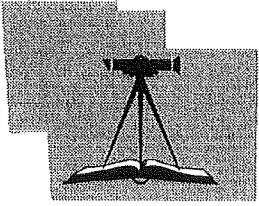

RE: Liberty Road North – Change in Highway Designation

Honorable Trustees:

Delaware County has recently improved portions of Home Road and Liberty Road in conjunction with the grade separation of Home Road and the CSX railroad. The realignment of Liberty Road North leaves the old portion of Liberty Road North as a dead-end road that services several residences and businesses. Next year, a cul-de-sac will extend west from the end of this road to provide access the Trucco property and the Del-Co water tower.

As you may be aware, the Ohio Revised Code defines the purposes of county highways and township roads. County highways are through roads that are intended to connect state highways or county roads. Township roads are other public roads outside of corporation limits that are not made part of the county or state highway system. Since this section of Liberty Road North is now essentially a long cul-de-sac, it does not meet the intent of a county highway, therefore we are recommending to the Board of Commissioners that it be declared a township road.

Upon resolution of the Board of Commissioners, this section of road will become known as Old Liberty Road (Township Road 9A) and be maintained by Liberty Township in perpetuity. While the Ohio Revised Code does not require any action of your Board, we would appreciate your concurrence with this proposed action through a resolution stating your acceptance of the new road. The new mileage will be certified by this office to ODOT and will provide a small increase in your share of state gas tax and motor vehicle registration fees.

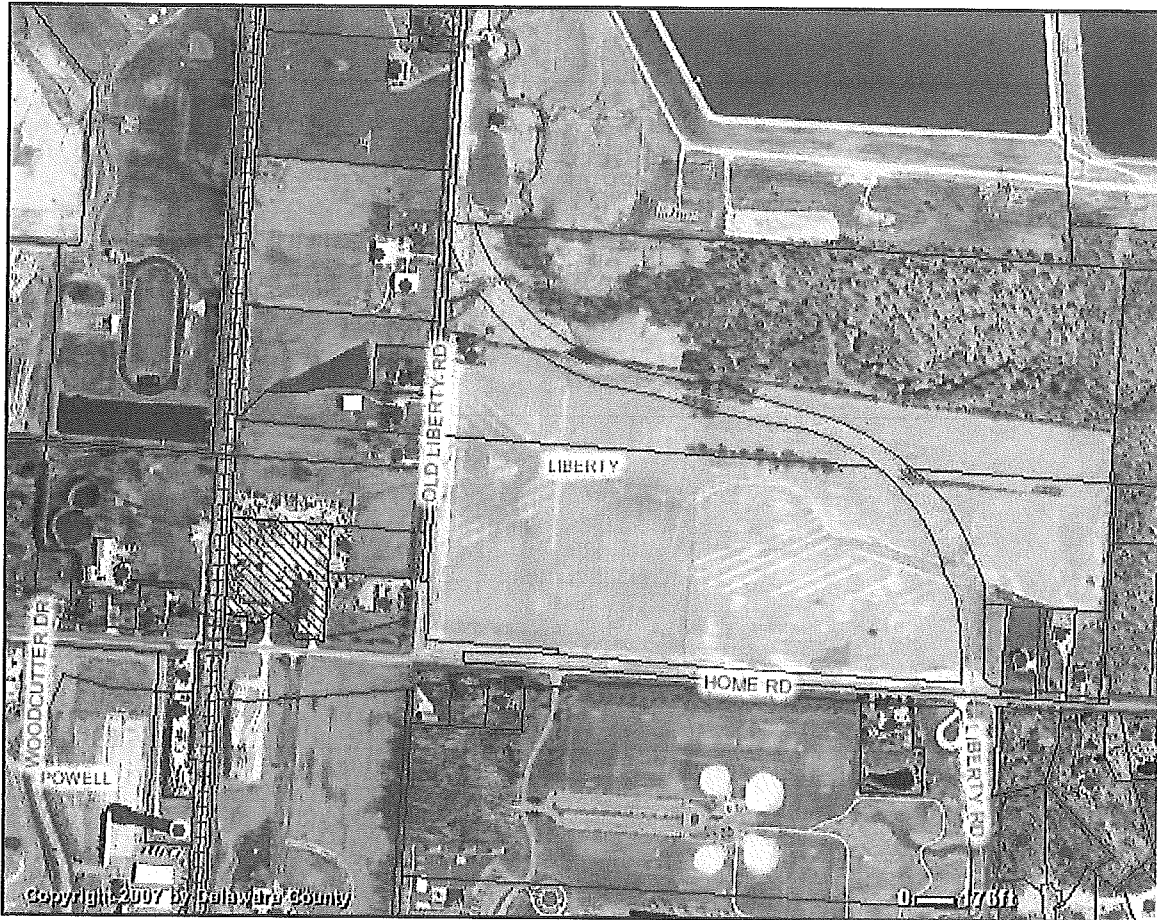
