

ROAD CLOSURE POLICY

Resolution No. 02-230

Whereas the Liberty Township Board of Trustees has been requested to close a township road by an authority with statutory ability to bond and perform public works, and

Whereas the safety of residents is affected by road closures, and,

Whereas the efficient administration of government gives trustees the ability to assign administration of policy,

Be it resolved that the Liberty Township Administrator may authorize a non-emergency, township road closure when the following conditions are met:

1. A 14-day advance notice (described above) has been given to all residents living in between the nearest public crossroads, and
2. No resident has stated an objection to the closure within 10 days of receiving road closure notice, and
3. All intersections of the nearest crossroads have been posted with sufficient signage to notify motorists of the dates of the impending road closure and intended detour routes 14 days in advance.
4. A public notice has been advertised in the newspaper of greatest subscription within Delaware County
