NOXIOUS WEEDS COMPLAINT FORM

ORC 5579.05 Notice to destroy weeds: Upon receiving written information that noxious weeds, wild parsnip, wild carrot, oxeye daisy, wild mustard, or other harmful weeds are growing on land in a township, other than land owned or managed by the department of natural resources, or park land owned or managed by the state or a political subdivision, the board of township trustees shall notify the owner, lessee, agent, or tenant having charge of the land of the receipt of the information and of the obligations imposed by this section. Within five days after the notification is given, the person notified shall cut or destroy the weeds or show the board why there is no need for doing so. If the person in charge of the land is a resident of the township or a nonresident whose address is known, the notice shall be sent to his address by certified mail. If the person's address is unknown, it is sufficient to publish the notice once in a newspaper of general circulation in the county.

ORC 5579.06 Effect of noncompliance with notice: If noxious weeds have not been destroyed, then the board of trustees shall cause the weeds to be cut or destroyed and may employ the necessary labor, materials, equipment to perform the task. All expenses incurred, shall, when approved by the board, be paid out of the township general fund from moneys not otherwise appropriated.

ORC 5579.07 Expense a lien upon land: The board of township trustees shall make a written report to the county auditor of the board's actions under ORC sections 5579.05 and 5579.06, with a statement of the board's charges for its services, the amount paid for the labor, materials, and equipment, and a proper description of the premises. These amounts, when allowed, shall be entered upon the tax duplicate, shall be a lien upon the land from the date of entry, and shall be collected as other taxes and returned to the township and placed in the township general fund.
