Liberty Township Announces Utility Aggregation Program Changes

New Energy Aggregation Consultant to be Selected

LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, OH – Today, Liberty Township Board of Trustees announced that they will not renew their contract with their current Energy Aggregation Consultant when the contract expires on July 22, 2021.

Prior to this ending date, participating residents' natural gas switched to public utilities on May 31, 2021, and their electrical utilities will switch to public utilities on July 22, 2021.

“For various reasons—but most importantly—having the best interest of our residents in mind, our current Energy Aggregation Consultant’s contract will not be renewed next month,” said Shyra Eichhorn, Liberty Township Board of Trustees Chair. “The Board of Trustees will do everything we can to make this transition period as cost-effective, easy, and seamless as possible.”

Currently, Liberty Township operates an opt-out aggregation program for natural gas and electric utilities. An opt-out aggregation program automatically enrolls all residents, unless they otherwise opt-out of the program. The Board of Trustees are in the process of evaluating options and various consultants, and no action is required of residents during this process.
