Liberty Township Fire Department Receives Lifesaving Equipment Grant Amidst New Safety Challenges

Grant is part of more than \$60 million given by Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation to public safety organizations across the U.S.

The funding will be applied toward the purchase of a virtual fire extinguisher training system, which will be used to build a safer community.

The equipment allows us to conduct the training indoors and anytime of the year. Expanding our fire prevention program will increase the safety and wellbeing of our community members,” said Tom O’Brien, fire chief, Liberty Township Fire Department. “During these unique and difficult times, we’re so thankful to the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation and our local Firehouse Subs in nearby Dublin.”

During the most recent grant cycle, the Foundation awarded 120 grants to public safety organizations nationwide. The 120 grants total nearly \$2.5 million and were given to organizations in need of critical lifesaving equipment.
