RESIDENTS SELECTED TO SERVE AS REPRESENTATIVES ON THE LIBERTY 2040 COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY COMMITTEE

LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, OH – Liberty Township has completed the application process seeking residents to serve on a Community Committee that will guide a long range, comprehensive planning effort known as Liberty 2040 – Community Plan. The Community Committee will be comprised of twelve residents --- three from each quadrant of the township --- as well as representatives from local businesses, schools and other key community organizations.

The township received dozens of applications from residents with various backgrounds and experiences. An application review team utilized a blind review process to select the following residents:
