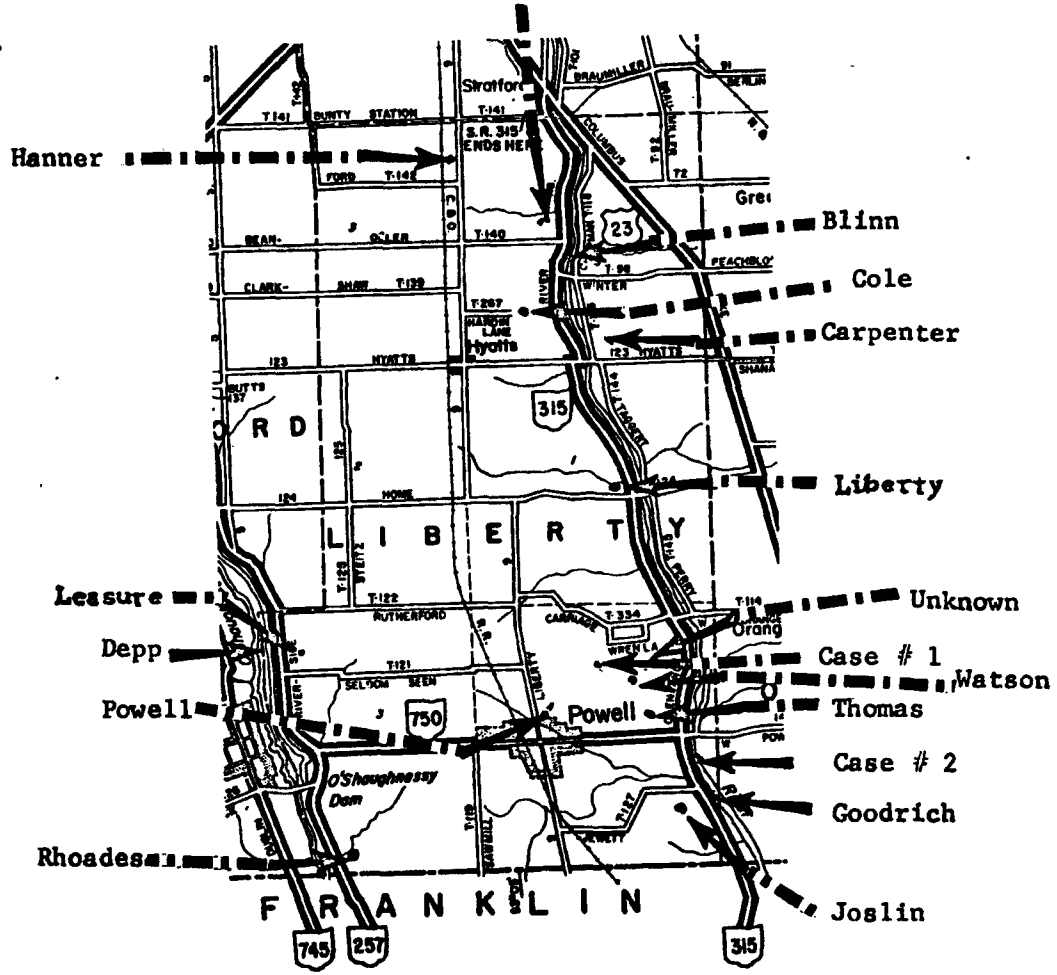
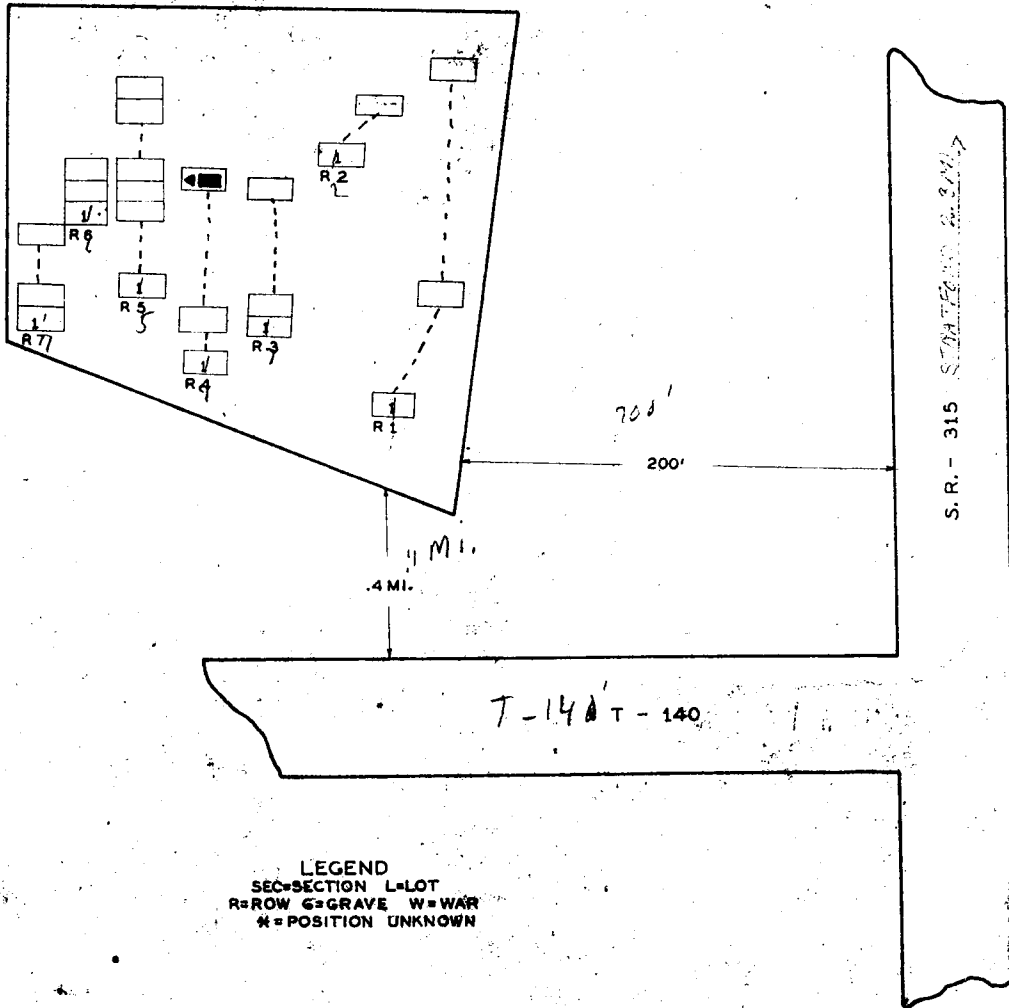

This cemetery is located on route 315 just South of Stratford on the Don Hughes Farm. It is on the right side of the road when traveling south, on a hill about 100 yards from the highway and just north of the house located on the former Stoney Brook Orchard. The graves are under some very large trees.

There were eight stones with legible inscription and one or two stones fallen face down which would have to be raised with a bar.

The above eight stones are in poor condition, several standing by the others are flat on the ground. They are a very hard stone and have weathered well.
