LIBERTY 2040 COMMUNITY COMMITTEE TO HOLD NEIGHBORHOOD MEETINGS **Meetings will Provide Opportunity for Citizen Feedback and Input**

LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, OH – The Liberty Township Community Committee, comprised of township residents and community stakeholders, will be holding a series of neighborhood meetings to discuss the Liberty 2040 – Community Plan. The Committee will be presenting the purpose of a comprehensive plan, as well as collecting feedback from residents on the work the Committee has completed to date. These meetings are open to the public, and residents are highly encouraged to attend. These meetings will be divided into four groups, with each group representing one “quadrant” of Liberty Township. Please see the map below.

The meetings will be held on the following dates, and at the following times and locations:

Quadrant A: August 4, 2022 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. held at Liberty Park – Shelters #1 and #2

Quadrant B: August 3, 2022 from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m., held at Columbus State Community College– Delaware Campus, Moeller Hall Rooms 111/112

Quadrant C: August 9, 2022 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., held at Liberty Township Meeting Room, 7761 Liberty Road

Quadrant D: August 11, 2022 from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. held at Liberty Park – Shelters #1 and #2

The Community Committee serves as a steering committee to guide the long range, comprehensive plan process. The Committee has spent the past few months working with a consultant, Crossroads Community Planning, LLC to complete a Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats analysis, establish a Vision Statement, and identify Values and Goals to serve as guiding principals for the comprehensive plan. The Committee has also created a draft of a Future Land Use Map for the Township, which will be discussed at each neighborhood meeting.

The goal of the comprehensive plan is to create a shared vision as well as values, goals, and action steps for future policy land use decisions. Resident input and participation are extremely important at this stage of the Liberty 2040 – Community Plan process.
