

RESOLUTION #19-0219-12

Entering into a 10-Year Contract with Delaware County for EMS

WHEREAS, in light of the fact that Delaware County operates a county wide EMS department funded by sales tax revenue, and in light of the recent recommendations set forth by the informal work group regarding improving service levels, and in light of the county's acknowledgement that it would cost the county \$750,000.00 annually to provide EMS services to Liberty Township, and in light of the estimated \$1,000,000.00 that it costs the County to operate one Delaware County EMS station and that the county operates ten such stations at a budget in excess of \$10,000,000.00, and in light of the county's recent withdrawal to provide EMS services to Liberty Township while the county provides EMS services completely to thirteen of its townships,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO to propose entering into a ten year contract with Delaware County whereby:

1. The County agrees that DELCOMM will oversee Liberty Township's run cards and assure the Township that the fastest/closest medical vehicle and any other necessary vehicles equipped to assist will be dispatched whether the call is perceived to be an ALS or a BLS call.
2. The county agrees to provide \$1,000,000.00 of funding to the Township on an annual basis to be paid in 4 equal quarterly payments designated to fund EMS services that the township provides to its residents.
